*TIPS FOR TEACHING PARENTS*

To fully discuss some things in Bible stories would only disturb our kids, for there are many things in the Bible that they may not be mature enough to know or to understand. To say more may provoke questions that will simply distract from the point of the lesson.

Can you think of a better way to begin a discussion of our bodies and how God made men and women different? Use such moments as God-given opportunities to prepare your youngsters for life.
