TIPS FOR TEACHING PARENTS

Each child has his or her own level of understanding and ability. Even children of the same age may vary widely in their capacities to study and to listen and to learn. So we must adjust our home teaching to fit the level of each child. Teaching that is too difficult or too simple will bore a child and may do more harm than good.

Some of our older children need to be challenged to go more deeply into the meanings of the Scriptures. Such verses as "I will give you the keys of the kingdom," or "if anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross," or "some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom" will give our older offspring some meat to cut their spiritual teeth on.

This is the genius of the Family Bible Study approach. Nobody knows our kids better than their parents. We are better equipped than any non-family teacher to assess our children's abilities and to challenge each child at the proper level.
