TO HELP US REMEMBER: Matthew 17:5b “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!”

TEEN THOUGHT:

When Jesus was placed side-by-side with two of the heroes of the Jewish faith, Moses and Elijah, Peter may have felt he was lifting up Jesus by honoring him on the same level as them. But the Father answered that **Jesus** was his **Son**, while Moses and Elijah were but faithful men. There are a lot of things clamoring for our attention: TV, magazines, school, sports, friends, politicians, even religious leaders. While all of these may have their places in our life, we must remember, most of all, to “Listen to **Him!**”
