TO HELP US REMEMBER:

John 8:31b-32: “Jesus said, ‘If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free.’”

TEEN THOUGHT:

In this life, we have a choice whether we will be children of God or children of the devil. We have a choice whether we will be slaves to sin, or be set free. Jesus speaks of the truth, where the devil speaks only lies. “The world” largely spews the devil’s lies at us, telling us that there is no absolute truth, that holding Jesus’ teaching frees us from fun, not sin, and that there is no heaven, hell, God or devil. But Jesus is the “light of the world”; whoever follows Him will never walk in darkness, but have the light of life (John 8:12). Which road will you take?

TIPS FOR TEACHING
