TO HELP US REMEMBER: John 14:16-17 "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever – the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you."

TEEN THOUGHT: Jesus told his disciples that it was good for them that Jesus was going to the Father, not just because it would redeem them of their sins, but because they would receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit had lived with them, but would now be in them. It may sound similar, but we are blessed with the closest relationship possible. And the Spirit living in us gives us priceless gifts – to be guided into all truth, and to have the fruits of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control grow in us. How can you let the Spirit guide your conscience?

TIPS FOR TEACHING

We are baptized into the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, though we tend to focus more on Jesus and the Father than the Spirit. The Holy Spirit has been revealed from Genesis 1 to Revelation 22, always working on our behalf – counseling, interceding, guiding, comforting, helping us in our weakness - giving us wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, and more. Study the scriptures below and thank God for sending his Spirit.
