Waiver and Assumption of Risk

As parent/legal guardian of _____ ("my child"), I hereby give permission for my child to participate in the retreat sponsored by the Pearland Church of Christ.

I understand that there are inherent risks in camp activities and that my child's participation in these activities may involve risk of harm or injury. I also understand that neither the Camp nor the D/FW Church of Christ (DFWCOC) provides any kind of accident or medical coverage insurance for campers. Knowing the potential risks and my own obligations and responsibilities, I consent to my child's participation in the camp activities associated with this retreat.

Further, I agree to assume any and all risks of injury, damage or death resulting from my child's participation involving without limitation, transportation to and from Camp, and release and discharge DFWCOC, its officers, directors, employees, agents and volunteers (collectively, the "Church") from all liability arising out of or in connection with camp attendance and/or activities from any cause other than the active negligence or willful misconduct of the church. For the purposes of this Authorization and Release, liability means all claims, demands, losses, causes of action, suits, or judgments of any and every kind that I, my heirs, executors, administrators, assignees or any other person or entity may have against the Church, because of death, personal injury or illness, or because of any loss or damage to property.

I have received, read, and understood and returned this Camp Authorization and Release Form, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions thereof, and am fully aware of the potential dangers incidental to my child's participation in the camp, and am aware of the legal consequences of signing this release.

What to Bring:

Clothing: A week's worth of clothes. Casual and comfortable but modest. Shorts are allowed, but please bring at least two pairs of long pants.

Personal Effects: Towels, soap, shampoo, washcloths, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.

Bedding: A sleeping bag or twin size bedding and a pillow.

For Activities: Swimsuits (girls should wear a one-piece only), sunscreen, play shoes that you could get muddy, t-shirts and shorts. You may also bring sports equipment like a football or baseball glove/bat, but it is your responsibility to keep track of them.

For Study: A Bible and a pen.

Optional: Camera, journal/ notebook

What not to Bring:

Knives, firearms, fireworks, water pistols, water balloons, iPods or CD players, tobacco products, shaving cream, a bad attitude, or anything else that might get you in trouble. If these items are brought, they will be confiscated.
