Luke

Special emphasis on repentance as the response the gospel requires

Luke

emphasizes repeatedly and explicitly the connection between repentance and remission (forgiveness) of sins

I came not to call the righteous, but sinners



I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.



Luke

in his history of the church (Acts), shows the call to repentance is central to the preaching of the gospel

The "Great Commission"

Matthew 28:18-20

make disciples of all nations, baptizing them...

Mark

16:15-16

Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized...

Luke

24:46-47

that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed...

And Peter said to them, Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.



Repent, therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out...

Contrast that with popular preaching today

They didn't preach:

"The Lord will bless you with prosperity!"

"Look at what our church has to offer you!"

"Just receive Christ into your heart."

Contrast that with popular preaching today

They didn't preach:

The Lord loves you so much. (This is true, of course)

"The Lord will make you a better person."
(This is true, of course)

Contrast that with popular preaching today

They did preach:

Salvation from sin is found only in Christ.

God's offer of salvation requires you to change your heart, your life, to turn away from sin.

just confessing sin

getting baptized, attending church services

repentance is not

saying "I'm sorry" and then continuing in sin

repentance is

a true desire to change

a longing to please God

Bear fruit in keeping with repentance.

repentance does not mean

we must "fix" everything in our lives before coming to God

repentance does mean

we may have to make radical changes in our lives

we may have to give up things that are difficult to give up

repentance does mean

we may have to get out of sinful relationships, situations

can be very costly

is worth the cost!
